Jodhpurs & Breeches	White, cream or beige breeches or jodhpurs										
Boots	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort										
Jackets, Shirts & Body Protectors	Jacket may be dark blue or black with white stock. Tweed jacket with coloured stock or collar and tie. White stocks, white American collar or white shirts with collar and tie may be worn. Body protectors may be worn. If worn, it should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.										
Hair & Jewellery	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally										
Gloves	Gloves must be worn										
Whips	Whips are not permitted in horse trials dressage, except in the warm up. However, for all other dressage and riding tests, whips are permitted <i>but must not be used in a way or be of a length that disturbs other riders and may not be picked up if dropped during a test.</i>										
Spurs	Spurs of designs which include necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks are not permitted. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs are compulsory for Medium Dressage. <i>For the horse trials, spurs must not exceed 4cm. Spurs will be measured from the back of the boot/inside of the spur.</i>										
Quarter marks	Quarter marks, if used, must be simple with no glitter or colouring.										

At the discretion of the judge, competitors may be permitted to ride without jackets in excessively hot weather, but a suitable shirt that fastens at the neck (not bright or multi-coloured) with a tie. American collar or correctly fastened stock must be worn. Shirts must have long sleeves. Plain, dark coloured waterproof coats may be worn in wet weather.

Boots	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort									
Jackets, Shirts & Body Protectors	Jackets may be any traditional style and colour . BS Jackets are not permitted. Show jumping shirts, white stocks, white American collar or white shirts with collar and tie may be worn. A body protector is recommended, if worn, it should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.									
Hair & Jewellery	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally									
Gloves	Gloves are optional									
Whips	MUST be between 45cm and 75cm and MUST not be weighted or with a hard point at the end									
Spurs	Spurs designs which include necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks are not permitted. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs with necks up to 3.5cm are allowed. For the horse trials, spurs must not exceed 4cm. Spurs will be measured from the back of the boot/inside of the spur.									

At the discretion of the judge, competitors may be permitted to ride without jackets in excessively hot weather, but a suitable shirt that fastens at the neck (not bright or multi-coloured) with a tie. American collar or correctly fastened stock must be worn. Shirts must have long sleeves. Plain, dark coloured waterproof coats may be worn in wet weather.

Boots	Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort										
Jackets, Shirts & Body Protectors	Sweatshirt or shirt. Hunting stock is recommended for safety. A body protector approved to Level 3 (Purple label) manufactured in the year 2000 or since MUST be worn and should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines. See also G22.3										
Hair & Jewellery	No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally.										
Gloves	Gloves are recommended.										
Whips	MUST be between 45cm and 75cm and MUST not be weighted or with a hard point at the end.										
Spurs	Spurs of designs which include necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks are not permitted. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards. Spurs with necks up to 4cm are allowed for Horse Trials. Spurs will be measured from the back of the boot/inside of the spur.										
Medical Armbands	Medical armbands are compulsory and MUST be properly completed with the relevant competitors details.										
Watches	Watches capable of being started and recording time elapsed are FORBIDDEN in one day, cross-country and FOTH Challenge events only. Competitors are NOT permitted to take mobile phones onto the course when competing. No receiving, recording, transmitting or monitoring device may be used by a competitor during any phase in an competition.

<p>Boots</p>	<p>Plain black or brown which may also be top boots or jodhpur boots. The boots should be a traditional style. Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boots and have no decoration of any sort.</p>										
<p>Jackets, Shirts & Body Protectors</p>	<p>Jacket may be dark blue or black with white stock. Tweed jacket with coloured stock or collar and tie. White stocks, white American collar or white shirts with collar and tie may be worn. Body protectors may be worn. If worn, it should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturers' guidelines.</p>										
<p>Hair & Jewellery</p>	<p>No jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercings are permitted. Hair must be neatly secured and MUST not hang lower than the shoulder line when standing normally.</p>										
<p>Gloves</p>	<p>Gloves must be worn.</p>										
<p>Whips</p>	<p>Whips may only be used in the jumping phase of working hunter pony/horse and working /cob classes. Show canes are allowed.</p>										
<p>Spurs</p>	<p>Spurs of designs which include necks set to inside of heel, spurs with roughened/cutting edges and serrated spurs with or without necks are not permitted. Spurs with smooth rowels not exceeding 1cm are allowed. Spurs may only be worn in the traditional manner, with the curve, if any, of the neck of the spur directed downwards.</p>
